*****NEW PROGRAM UPDATE - RUNSPOOL*****

New automatic running spooler during the day, to update home office systems with store information

This program RUNSPOOL needs to be placed into every /Z/RSSS/RUN directory on all systems.

If the system date is 10:00am or later, and one has a batch name in the spooler named HOURLY and the file on the root drive /SPOOLHOURLY is empty, then it runs the batch called HOURLY and use today's date where dates are blank.

One can have other batch names to run at different times, but in order to run those names, the SPOOLHOURLLY need to designate that.

The root cron file will also need to be updated to reflect the times to run the HOURLY spooler throughout the day.

```
21 09 * * * /usr/bin/zrunspool < /dev/null > /dev/null 2> /dev/null
```

This is the line that will generate off the spooler run.

The output of the success or failure of this new batch is output to /SEND/HOURYLST.

This program can be used if you are doing TCP/IP polling and you want to update the home office with current store information on a more timely basis.
